## The 2013 MACE Annual Meeting

The 2013 MACE(Mongolian Association of Civil Engineers) Annual Meeting was held on June 13-15, 2013, at Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. The theme for the International Roundtable Meeting was "Safety in Construction". KSCE President, *Prof. Jongsung Sim* (Hanyang University), *Dr. Jungju Bea* and *Dr. Jae Woan Ryu* from the Korea Infrastructure Safety & Technology Corporation (KISTEC) participated in this year's meeting as the KSCE representatives. *Dr. Bea* made a presentation titled "Construction Safety Policies & Systems in Korea", and shared valuable knowledge in construction safety awareness, legal systems to secure safety, and construction safety management system in Korea.

## 6th Civil Engineering Conference in the Asian Region (CECAR6)

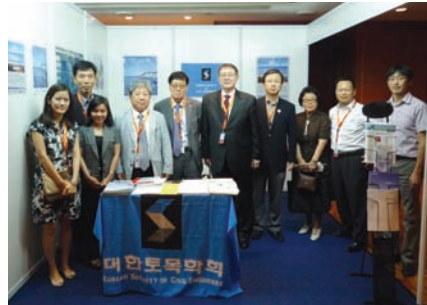
The CECAR6 was held on August 20-22, 2013, at Hotel Borobudur, Jakarta, Indonesia, under the theme, "Embracing the

Future through Sustainability". The CECAR is organized by the Asian Civil Engineering Coordinating Council (ACECC) triennially since 1998. This year's conference was hosted by the Indonesian Society of Civil and Structural Engineers (HAKI). A total of 652 participants registered and 236 papers were submitted. Among 236 papers, 88 registrants and 46 papers were from Korea. At the conference, there were 8 Keynote Speeches, 28 Technical Sessions, 6 Special Sessions, 5 other programs including the Presidential Session on Infrastructure, and 2 Short Courses. Other participating countries include Indonesia (77 papers), Japan (42 papers), Taiwan (36 papers), Malaysia

(7 papers), Australia (5 papers), USA (3 papers), India (3 papers), Portugal (1 paper), Netherlands (1 paper), Mongolia (1 paper), Iran (1 paper), Hong Kong (1 paper), Germany (1 paper), England (1 paper), China (1 paper) and Philippines (9 papers).

As for the exposition, the organizers prepared booths for ACECC member societies in addition to corporate exhibition booths. Representing Korea, the KSCE, Korea Land and Housing Corporation, and K-water have participated in the exhibition.

ACECC honored the Four Rivers Restoration Project by K-water with the 2013 ACECC Outstanding Civil Engineering Project Award, and *Dr. Chun-Su Chon*, fellow member of KSCE, awarded the 2013 ACECC Civil Engineering Achievement Award. Civil Harmony of KSCE presented their sweet melody at the Gala Dinner, celebrating the success of the conference and congratulating the awardees for their achievements.

On the last day the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) took over the position of chair country and announced the CECAR7(2016) to be held in Hawaii. In addition, Dr. Kenichi Horikoshi of JSCE was appointed as the Secretary General of ACECC. Finally, the Jakarta Protocol - Civil Engineering for a Sustainable Future - has been agreed and signed by all participating ACECC member societies to commit on the sustainable development, dealing with climate change, disasters, and other challenges. we are facing today.
